Autism Month has been the subject of protest from individual and organizations in Canada, "powerful advocacy awareness campaigns and organizations that fund them led by non-autistic people — continue to portray autistic people negatively" and, continue to focus on cures. Words such as "inclusion," "acceptance" are their campaigns, not meaning what they mean, but advancing the rhetoric of an autism disorder. As parents and researchers, there is not a need.

Autistic people experience higher rates of bullying. Families struggle with the stigmatizing, and the lack of the meaningful relevant, so called, "help". **1. Awareness. M**ainstream media still limits diverse representation. **2. Perspective.** Rather than focus on charitable organizations and "helping," we need to turn our attention to [not]. **3. Leadership.** The guidance and leadership is about normal (there's no such thing as autistic), as it's being taught. We need to focus away from "blue lights, ribbons or other gimmicks", **4. Neurodiversity.** Talk of a disorder must be left behind, and replaced with [4 columns and 6 rows], altered by me. **5. Inclusion.** We need to rectify the persistent exclusion of other viewpoints. We all have deficits.

"This April, and every month, we need to reconsider the World" of less social skills from the perspective of people with less social skills themselves. This was a really good article, I think.
